Information Automatically Collected and Stored:

We temporarily store the following information about your visit:

- The name of the domain you use to access the Internet e.g. aol.com if you are using an American Online account or uic.edu if you are connecting from the University of Illinois at Chicago's domain.
- Your User Agent which contains information about your computer such as your Operating System and Browser.
- Date and Time of Your Visit
- Pages You Visit
- The time you remain on each page.
- Your Web Site Address
- Searches Performed

We use this information for statistical and security purposes. This helps make our site more useful to visitors. Unless specifically stated, no additional information will be collected.

Personally Provided Information:

Personal information is not required to visit our web sites.

If you provide additional information through an e-mail, form, survey, etc., we will retain the information until we fulfill the stated purpose of the communication.
